**Father Alex Thoughts: Theme: Touch Me**. On this Third Sunday of Easter, Jesus calls us to be authentic in our life and in our relationship with Him and with one another. We have bodies, but with souls. So we are not corpses. We have souls, but with bodies. So we are not ghosts. We are human beings, men and women created by God and redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ, destined to share in the eternal life and glory in God's heavenly kingdom.
