**Welcome to you all.** Masses at St Henry Morse are usually on Saturday at 6pm, on Sunday at 9am and 11.30am, and on Wednesdays at 9.30am. It would be **really helpful** if parishioners could **arrive for Mass in plenty of time** to allow for checking in at the door. Last minute arrivals can cause disruption at the start of Mass.

**Important Note:** There will be **no mass at 11.30 am on Sundays while Fr. Alex is away.** We are very grateful to Fr. Steve Blair who will cover for Fr. Alex while he is taking annual leave. Masses will be on Saturday at 6 pm, Sunday at 9.00 am and Wednesday at 9.30 am. **There will be no 9.30 mass on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October.**

**Advance booking is strongly recommended** for the 6pm Saturday Mass and the 9am Sunday Mass especially now given that there is no 11.30 mass on Sunday for the next few weeks. If you arrive without booking, and the church is full, you risk having to be turned away.
