A Covid-19 Update - August 2021:

Government guidelines have changed with regards to the lifting of Covid restrictions, and Fr. Alex has considered the latest Bishops' guidance and the views of parishioners, the majority of which were in favour of maintaining current arrangements. He has decided to make no change to existing arrangements for masks and social distancing at this time. This will be reviewed again on September 14th.

Although advance booking is no longer essential, space is limited, and so advance booking is strongly recommended for all weekend Masses, especially the 6pm Saturday Mass and the 9am Sunday Mass. If you arrive without booking, and the church is full, you risk having to be turned away. Please book via email mass@holyltrinitydiss.plus.com, but If you do not have access to email you should call 01379 871944 or 01379 897251.

If you have not booked in advance, and there is space in the church, you can register on arrival by using your mobile phone and the QR code posted outside the church. You need to have the NHS COVID-19 app to do this. If you do not have a mobile phone with this facility then you can register by signing in with your contact details as you enter the church.

Father Alex's Thoughts - Theme: Faith Demonstrated Through Action. Today, the twenty-fourth Sunday of ordinary time, WE honour and celebrate Christ, the son of God, who humbly accepted the weakness of our human condition. He demonstrated his solidarity with us by generously renouncing himself and taking up the cross. Practical Christianity means accepting to carry one's cross humbly and patiently while relying on the same grace that helped Christ. It is by taking his cross and dying on it that Christ demonstrated his love and generosity for us. So, he wants us to do the same. Practical faith helps us to understand and live the mystery of the cross. Faith without action is dead. We are all encouraged in our liturgy today to follow the admonitions from our readings and embrace the reality of our faith as Christians and children of God. May God grant us the grace to demonstrate our faith through our actions. Amen!
